- ◆ Active participation in negotiations on finance, agriculture & capacity building




## Early Start & WGC Engagement

## Sharm el-Sheikh Dialogue Workshop - Virtually from Cameroon



Virtually, we followed the first 2025 workshop under the Sharm el-Sheikh Dialogue on the Paris Agreement scope.

- ◆ Key focus was placed on **capacity-building** for national systems to access climate finance.
- ◆ Discussions stressed that **adaptation needs vary** greatly across regions, and a one-size-fits-all approach will not work.
- ◆ The session also explored **cross-sectoral coordination**, emphasizing the importance of aligning public, private, and civil society actors.
- ◆ There was a strong call for using **language that is accessible**, and climate communication must break away from technical jargon and speak to the realities of local communities.
- ◆ This space continues to be key in **bridging negotiations with lived experiences**, especially from the Global South.
