WGC Caucus leading the day



Started the day with our usual engagement at the Women & Gender Constituency (WGC) caucus, aligning on strategies, key messages, and cross-constituency priorities.



Disability-Inclusive Climate Action



Attended a critical side event on **Gender-Just & Disability-Inclusive Climate Action**, led by the International Disability Alliance (IDA).

- They called for **disaggregated data**, intentional inclusion, and recognition of unique challenges faced by persons with disabilities in the climate space.



Intervention by Dr. Zoneziwoh Mbonggulo-Wondieh



In a moving intervention, Dr. Zoneziwoh emphasised that gender-transformative climate action is not a luxury; It's a necessity.

At the end, she emphasised that *"No woman should ever be forced to choose between career or be reminded of the domestic reproductive role"*, and raised concerns on **visa denials** that exclude voices from key global spaces.

Negotiators moved forward with refining the **Enhanced Lima Work Programme and GAP**. Discussions covered:

- Capacity strengthening & knowledge sharing
- Meaningful participation
- Monitoring & reporting coherence
