- ◆ **Color of the Day:** ■ **Orange**
- ◆ **Message:** Plastic pollution is injustice.
- ◆ **Focus:** The health risks plastics pose, especially to women's health
- ◆ **WFAC joined global advocates to spotlight the human cost of inaction**



Negotiations: Tensions & Hopes



Delegates continued working through the Chair's Text.

- ◆ **The pace remains slow as countries seek consensus**
- ◆ **Everyone wants to leave Geneva with a meaningful instrument**
- ◆ **Only 2 negotiation days remain before Saturday's plenary**
- ◆ **The world watches and waits for a treaty rooted in justice**

- ◆ **Civil society continues to push for bold, rights-based commitments**
- ◆ **WFAC stands firm in calling for a feminist, health-centered treaty**
